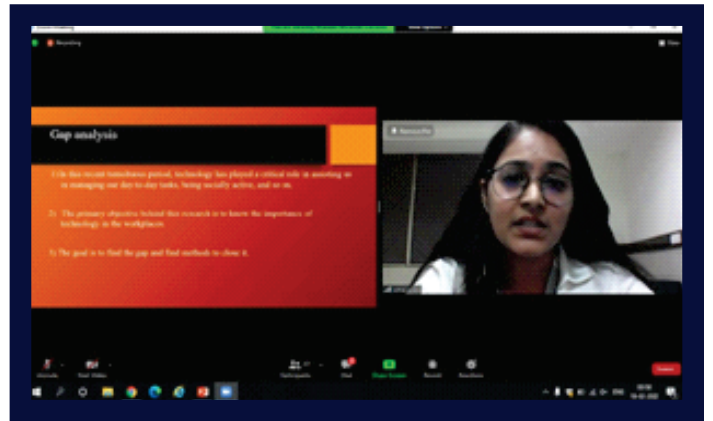
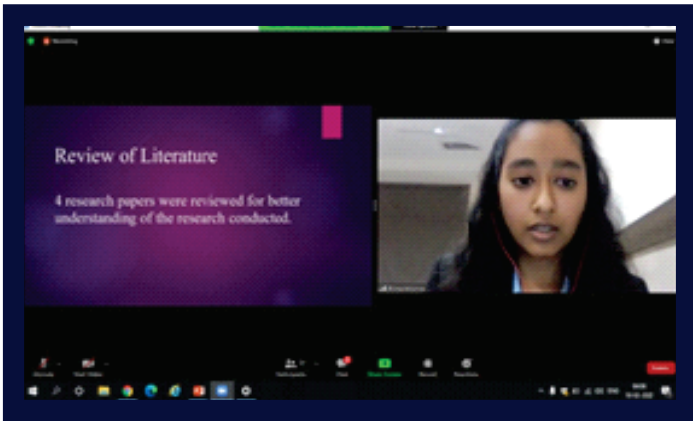
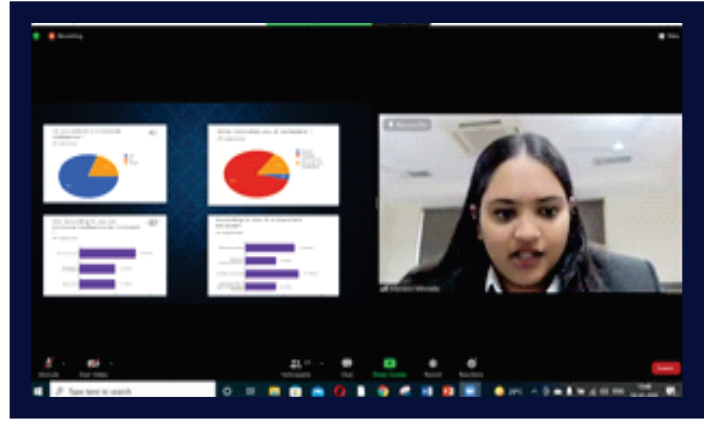
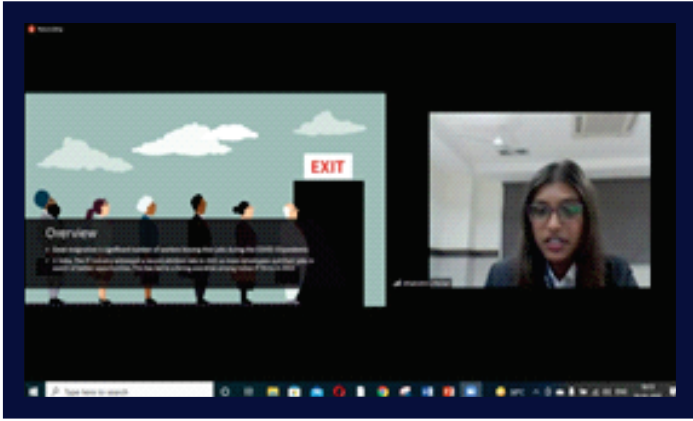
Excel Training, FMHO : February 13, 12 & 27 , 2022

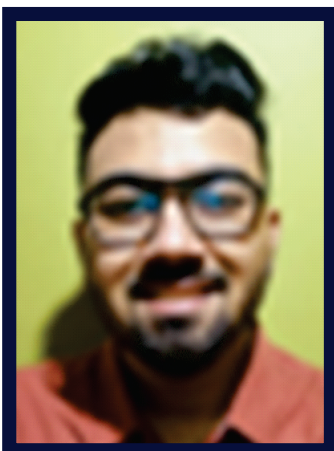
