
## **EVENTS**

TGBS conducted a four-day orientation program for students. The orientation programme focussed upon re-engineering & reinforcing learning acquired in Sem I.










#### SRC Cell Event - National Youth Day







## **GUEST SESSIONS**








### 3. The first phonebook only had 50 names.


The book was a page long. However, it was considered as an important step towards printed directories.
